Donations Policy

Policy Statement

It is the policy of Upwood and the Raveleys Parish Council to promote well-being and to support and encourage local organisations which provide facilities and services for the community.

Section 137 ("the Power of Well-Being) of the Local Government Act, 1972 makes provision for the Council to spend a limited amount on activities for which it has no specific power, but which it considers will directly promote or improve the economic, social or environmental well-being of the fabric of the Parish or its Parishioners.

Conditions of Donation

- 1. All requests must be made on the attached form and submitted preferably by 31 October for consideration in the following financial year (beginning 01 April).
- 2. Requests will only be considered for those projects or initiatives which directly benefit the fabric of the Parish or the residents of Upwood and the Raveleys.
- 3. All requests will be considered at the Parish Council meeting following receipt by the Clerk (Members of the public are welcome to observe all Council meetings).
- 4. S137 funds are limited and the Parish Council will agree on the level of support it can provide in each case. The requested amount will be used as a guide only.
- 5. The decision of the Parish Council is final.
