Gravel Pits.

Proposed by Mr. Collett seconded by Mr. G. Thompson and resolved that Mr. Kidman making the necessary arrangement with Mr. Orriss for the letting of the Parish Gravel Pits etc. for the ensuing year.

Cheques.
