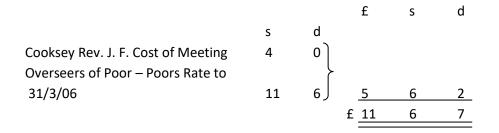
#### Gravel Pits, re Letting of.

#### Resignation of John Evison Esq're.

Letter dated October 5<sup>th</sup> 1906 from Mr. John Evison tendering his resignation as a Member of the Parish Council on leaving the village was read, when it was proposed by Mr. Reginald J. Kidman, seconded by Mr. Albert Henry Ingle, and resolved that Mr. John Evison's resignation be accepted with regret, and that the Clerk be requested to write to him to that effect.

#### Audit, Attendance at.

The Clerk reported that he had attended the Audit at Huntingdon this day, in accordance with due notice received, and that the Auditor had certified the Accounts to be correct.

### Allotment Rents, Time for Receiving.

Proposed by Rev'd John F. Cooksey, seconded by Mr. George Thompson, and resolved that the Council meet in the National School on Friday the 19<sup>th</sup> inst. at 7 o'clock in the evening to receive the Allotment Rents due at Michaelmas last, and that Members present attend thereat as far as practicable.

#### Rent Committee, Authority of.

Proposed by Rev'd John F. Cooksey, seconded by Mr. George Thompson, and resolved that Members of the Council attending to receive the Allotment Rents be and are hereby authorised to deal with Allotment Holders in arrear, and application for Allotments as circumstances may render advisable.

#### Allotments – No. 4 and 23 written back as irrecoverable.

The Clerk reported that Edgar Darwood, formerly tenant of No. 4 Allotment, Rent due Michaelmas 1905, 5/5, had become bankrupt, and that Harry Ilett, formerly tenant of No. 23 Allotment, Rent due Michaelmas 1905, 2/4½, had left the village, and an application addressed to the latter at 39 Palmerston Road, Kettering, had been returned marked 'Not Known'. As there did not to be any prospect of obtaining the arrears it was proposed by Mr. Reginald J. Kidman, seconded by Mr. Albert Henry Ingle, and resolved that the amounts above mentioned be written off as irrecoverable.
