Communication Local Government Board re Clerks Salary.

A communication was read from the Local Government Board respecting the Clerks salary and the preparation of the Registration of Voters lists.

The Board suggested in their circular letter that the Clerks duties should be clearly defined including the preparation of the voters list, and a proper salary allowed for such work.

The Clerk explained to the Council that his salary had been fixed at a very low rate owing to the fact that the Revising Barrister made an allowance for Registration Work, and as recent legislation had annulled this work for the time being, he would lose about seven pounds this half year. On a motion proposed by Colonel Mowbray, seconded by Mr. G. Thompson, the matter was adjourned till the next meeting.
