#### 29/03-12 Annual Accounts 2010/11

### 30/03-12 Parish Council Report As Read At the Meeting on the 5<sup>th</sup> March 2012

At the meeting held on the 5<sup>th</sup> March, the Chairman read aloud a report describing how the previous clerk managed to defraud the Parish Council leading to her conviction earlier this year. The Parish Council have taken time to reflect upon the report and a resolution to acknowledge this as the final document is required.

Prior to its reading at the previous meeting, the report had been reviewed by the legal department of the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Administration of Local Councils organisation and by Huntingdonshire's democratic services department, both of which agreed the reports' content was acceptable following evidence revealed during the investigation of the previous clerk leading to her conviction for fraud.

The Chairman asked the councillors if they acknowledged the report and there was no dissent. The clerk accepted the acknowledgement as unanimous acceptance of the report.

The previous chair of the Parish Council, in post at the time to which the report refers, was present at this meeting. The clerk was asked to forward a copy of the report to him by e mail and should he wish to comment on its' content, he would be at liberty to do so at the next meeting. It was decided the report would not be publicised in any way but would be available as a public document if requested.
